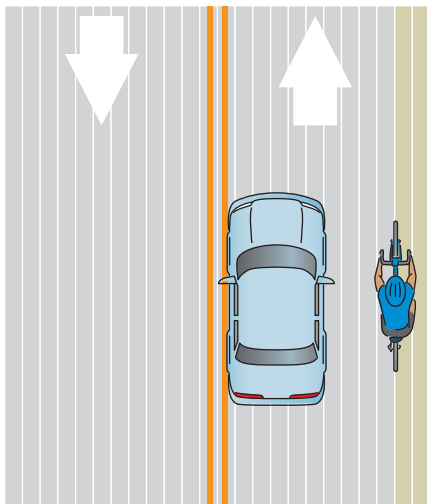
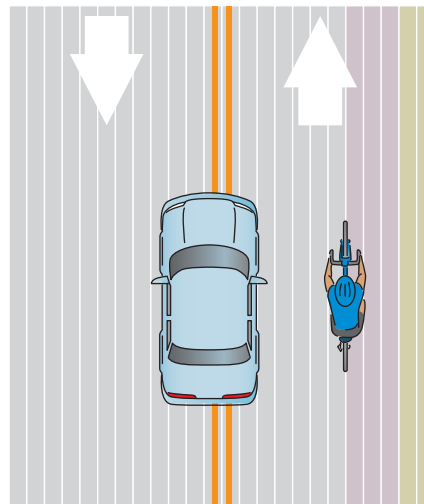


How to Get more Passing Clearance

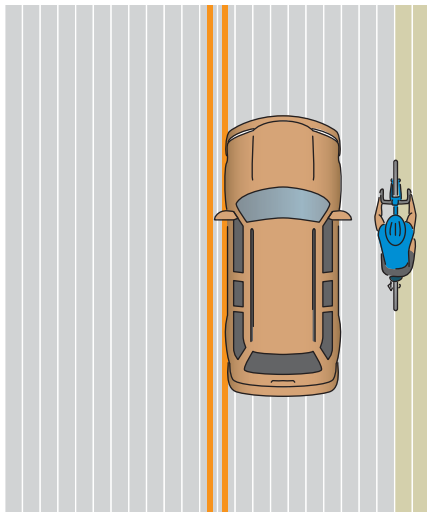
Riding too far right encourages same-lane passing. Cyclists should move left to encourage a lane change.



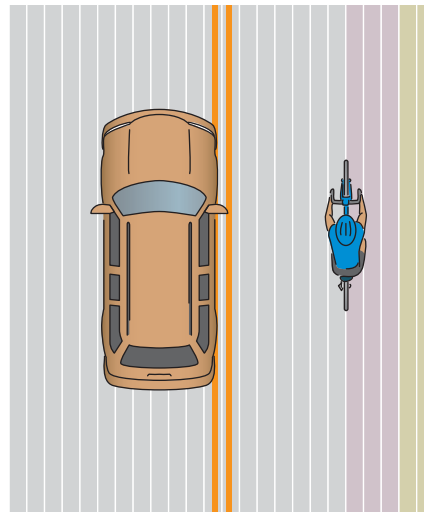
Clearance: 2 feet



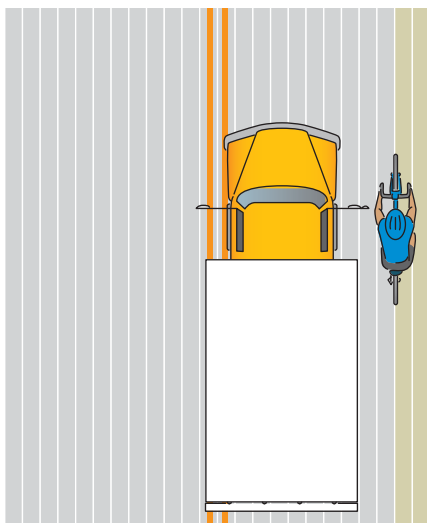
Straddle-pass
Clearance: ~3 feet



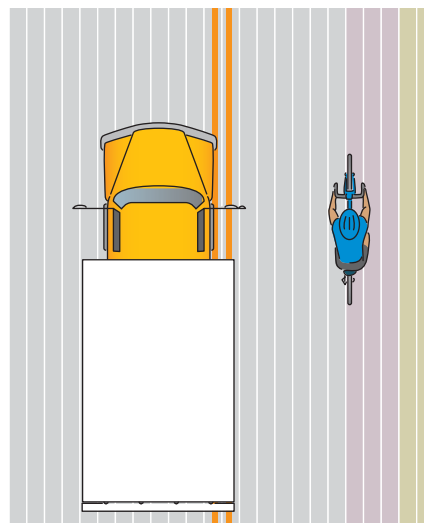
Clearance: 1 foot



Full Lane Change
Clearance: ~6 feet



Clearance: 0



Encouraging a full lane change reduces the dangers from drivers of large vehicles misjudging their clearance.
