ABOUT THIS STUDY: As part of Orlando's continuing commitment to improving the availability and effectiveness of bicycling routes and trails, the City of Orlando has contracted with HDR to conduct a study that began in September 2013, and will continue until Fall 2014. Using GIS data, maps, studies, and plans from the City and adjacent jurisdictions, an assessment of the network of trails will be produced, noting overall health and connectivity of the trails and identifying significant network gaps.
